## CAMPUS CREW - HIGHSCHOOL & COLLEGE

1. Fully accomplished Entry and Waiver form
2. Clear Photocopy or Scanned Copy of Valid School ID of each members
3. Clear Scanned copy or photocopy of NSO Birth Certificate or Passport of each member
4. Proof of enrollment of each members - i.e. School Registration Form, Certification from the Registrar with school seal)
5. Endorsement Letter with school seal stating the group's name and its members, allowing them to join and represent the school in this competition
6. Group Logo (High Resolution)
7. School Logo (High Resolution)
8. Group Write Up (Introduction spiel of the group)
9. PHP 500 (USD 10) Registration Fee per member of the group

## REGISTRATION PROCESS

1. Interested group is required to pre-register online on or before December 28, 2018 thru [www.actsdanceacademy.net/dancesupremacy-registration](http://www.actsdanceacademy.net/dancesupremacy-registration) Once registered, the group will be shortlisted but will not yet be considered an official participant unless they are able to complete the next steps.
2. Group must submit complete requirements on or before January 19, 2019. Submit requirements via the following:

For groups within Metro Manila, please hand carry all requirements at ACTS Dance & Arts Academy.

For groups outside Metro Manila and the Philippines, please submit requirements through [www.actsdanceacademy.net/dancesupremacy-registration](http://www.actsdanceacademy.net/dancesupremacy-registration) online submission of documents. No email submission will be accepted.



3. This is first come first serve. Only the first 30 groups for the Big Crew Division, first 20 groups for the Small Crew Division, first 20 groups for the Campus Crew Highschool and first 20 groups for the Campus Crew College Division that will be able to accomplish Steps 1 to 2 on or before the deadline will be declared an official participant.
4. Once declared an official participant, group must pay the Registration Fee of Php500.00 (USD 10) per member. Payments can be made directly at ACTS Dance & Arts Academy or via Bank Deposit at this account:

## PERFORMANCE AND STAGE RULES

This competition aims to challenge dance groups to create fresh, creative and original dance pieces. Participants are highly encouraged to put concepts, stories, theme and identity to their dance pieces.

### Genre

Participating groups can perform any Street Dance Style but is not limited to Street Dance alone. Using other genres such as contemporary, ballet, interpretative, or tribal, etc. that will help the group in portraying the concept of their piece is allowed and encouraged.

### Music

For Big Crew, maximum of four minutes (4:00).

For small crew, maximum of two minutes (2:00)

For campus crew, maximum of two minutes and 30 seconds (2:30)

Final edited music must be submitted on or before March 2, 2019.

### Costume & Props

Handheld Props & Huge Props/set will be allowed. Groups will also be allowed to wear any costume that they want as long as it will be wholesome and not offensive.

## CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

CRITERIA	SCORE
<b>Concept</b> (Includes choreography, costume, props, and music)	25%
<b>Skill &amp; Technique</b> (Musicality, Dance Technique, and Mastery of Style)	25%
<b>Creativity</b> (Elements & Use of Space)	20%
<b>Performance &amp; Execution</b> (Synchronization, Precision, Showmanship)	20%
<b>Audience Appeal</b> (Entertainment Value)	10%

## POINT DEDUCTION

VIOLATION	DESCRIPTION	POINT DEDUCTION
<b>Unsecured attire</b>	Untied shoe laces, loose hats or any part of the costume that obviously fell off because it was not intact or secured properly	.05 for every item
<b>Prohibited Substances</b>	Use of body oils, paints and other substance that will compromise the dryness of the stage area.	.05
<b>False Start</b>	Failure to start after the music is played	.10
<b>Fall / Trip</b>	A member falls from a lift, or during a performance that is highly noticeable, recoverable or not	.10
<b>Late Start</b>	Failure to go up on stage within 20 seconds after being called	.05
<b>Music length</b>	Music either exceeds required length	.10 (every 10 seconds or a fraction of)



<b>Foul language</b>	The music contain audible foul language that is inappropriate for all audiences.	.10 per word
<b>Improper gesture</b>	A member or all of the members exhibit inappropriate gestures and shouts foul language during the performance	.10
<b>Throws at Audience</b>	Props or clothing thrown towards the audience area	.10
<b>Late Submission of Music</b>	Group submitted their music after the given deadline	.05

### DISQUALIFICATION

Groups that will submit falsified documents will automatically be disqualified to join for three (3) consecutive years. Conducts of unsportsmanship and disrespect to the judges, company brand and organizing committee will be a ground for disqualification.

### GENERAL ASSEMBLY

There will be a General Assembly for all official participants on March 2, 2019 at the ACTS Dance & Arts Academy.
